**Adverse Effects of Anti-Diarrhoea Drug**

1681. SHRI N. GIRI PRASAD: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware of the adverse comments regarding Anti-diarrhoea drugs for children;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) what are the steps being taken to ban anti-diarrhoea drugs for children?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND): (a) to (c). Yes,

Sir.. Some of the anti-diarrhoeal preparations reportedly do not afford adequate anti-diarrhoeal activity and may cause side-effects instead. A specially constituted Committee of experts is screening anti-diarrhoeal preparations for children.

**46th Session of WHO**

1682. SHRI MAHENDRA PRASAD: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether 46th Session of WHO was held in New Delhi;

(b) if so, whether it was stated in the conference that WHO should help India and other over-populated countries to check the population;

(c) whether spreading of threat of AIDS in various cities was also discussed in the conference; and

(d) to what extent WHO has agreed to help in containing the population and checking the spread of AIDS?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND): (a) Yes, Sir, it was a meeting of the Regional Committee.

(b) The Minister of Health & F.W. in his inaugural address emphasised the inseparable linkage between poverty and over-population and urged WHO to set the pace at the global regional and country levels to help over-populated countries stabilise population at optimum levels.

(c) Yes, Sir.

(d) WHO continues to provide technical assistance and promote mutual cooperation for this purpose.
