TELUGU GANGA PROJECT

3482. **SHRI V. NARAYANA SWAMY :** Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state :

(a) whether Tamilnadu Government have requested the Andhra Pradesh Government for quick implementation of Telugu Ganga Project;

(b) if so, the reaction of that Government;

(c) the estimated cost of the project and when it is likely to be implemented; and

(d) what is the role of the Central Government in the matter of helping the States financially ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI P. K. THUNGAN) :

(a) to (c) The Government of Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu have decided to complete essential works of Telugu Ganga Project needed to deliver drinking water to Madras city by June, 1995. The latest estimated cost of the project is Rs. 1307 crores at 1991-92 standard schedule of rates of Andhra Pradesh Government. The project is scheduled to be completed by 1999—2000.

(d) The cost of the project is to be shared by the Governments of Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu on a mutually agreed basis.
