1106. SHRI B.K.HARIPRASAD: Will Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUS TRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Asia's largest fruit juice processing plant NERAMAC at Nalkatta in Tripura is on the verge of closure due to lack of financial and administrative back-up; and
- (b) whether the Central Government propose to come to the rescue of this unit, equipped with most sophisticated equipments from Sweden, Italy and USA, and substaining the livelihood of thousands of pineapple growers in the region through a rehabilitation package?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI TARUN GOGOI): (a) No. Sir.

(b) The Ministry of Food Processing Industries has been granting financial assistance to NERAMAC in view of its financial difficulties. NERAMAC has been purchasing pineapple from the pineapple growers of the region for its processing plant at Nalkatta in Tripura.

Implementation of Dual Policy in (be Deep Sea **Fishery Sector**

- (a) whether Government are implementing a dual policy with regard to Indian entrepreneurs and Foreign entrepreneurs in the deep sea fishery sector;

- (c) whether such an approach in favour of foreign investment is likely to endanger our natural resources;
- (d) the step being taken to evolve a more even handed approach for the two sectors?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI TARUN GOGOI): (a) to (d) There is no dual policy with regard to Indian entrepreneurs and Foreign entrepreneurs in deep sea fishery sector. No permission has been given to foreign entrepreneurs for deep sea fishing in Indian waters. However, permissions have been given to Indian Companies to enter into Joint Ventures with Foreign entrepreneurs, involving foreign investment for deep sea fishing operations in Indian waters.. Deep sea fishing vessels acquired under such projects are registered as per Indian rules and operated in the same manner as fully owned Indian vessels.
