THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINIS-TRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOP-MENT (DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA): (a) As per the selected Educational Statistics, 1991-92 (as on 30-9-1991) published by Govt. of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Education, there were 1202 Teacher Training Schools and 538 Teacher Training Colleges in the Country. The State-wise information is given in the attached statement. (See below).

(b) The enrolment position in these institutions during the last three years is as under:

(c) and (d) Teacher Training Institutes are opened by the State Governments or by private organisations with the approval of the State Government concerned or affiliated with the university concerned which is located in the State.

However, under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Restructuring and Reorganisation of Teacher Education financial assistance is provided to the State Governments for setting up of District Institutes of Education and Training (DEETs), College of Teacher Education (CTEs) and Institutions of Advanced Study in Education (IASEs). In the case of Gujarat, financial assistance has been provided for setting up of 17 DIETS, 5 CTEs and 1 IASE. The Govt. of Gujarat has been requested to send proposals for setting up of more DIETs/CTEs/IASEs. Proposals are awaited.

(e) The scheme of Restructuring and Reorganisation of Teacher Education has been implemented since 1987-88. The details of financial assistance to Government of Gujarat are as under:—
