### Jawans working on daily wages in C. R. P. F.

SHRI N. GIRI PRASAD :

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that about 3000 Jawans are working on daily wages in the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF);

(b) whether it is a fact that these Jawans have served continuously for about four years and still remain on daily wages; and

(c) if the answers to parts (a) and (b) above

be in affirmative, the details thereof and reasons for not making them permanent?

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI S. B. CHAVAN): (a) to (c) 2011 Constables are working in 6 Auxiliary Bns. of CRPF, on a consolidated honorarium of Rs. 30 per day, besides ration money. Of these, 1479 Constables are in service since 1989 and 533 since 1991. 572 Aux. Constables who satisfied the regular recruitment standards of CRPF, have been absorbed in the regular Battalions.
