ground stowing in the under mines have been carried out by the Cent ral Mining Research Stations (CMRS), Dhanbad on samples ash taken from a few nearby ther power stations. Small quantities of ash are being utilised alongwith sand for stowing purpose at Samadoba underground mine of Tata and Steel Company (TISCO) and Central Saunda underground mine of Central Coalfields Limited on ex perimental basis. According to investigations so far laboratory ducted by the Central Mining Research Station (CMRS), Dhanbad there is a possibility of utilising thermal tion ash to the extent of about 15 sand per cent alongwith river purposes. Committee stowing Α has been set up by the Department of Science and Technology under the aegies of Technology Mission for fly ash disposal and utilisaiton.
