Telecom Infra-structure to Foreign Investors

3647. SHRI V. HANUMANTHA RAO: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to open Telecom infrastructures to foreign investors;

(b) what are the details of the policy, specifically mentioning which areas of infra-structure will be opened up;

(c) what benefits will accrue to the Indian telephone user from such an open door policy;

(d) whether prices of telephone services will come down by such competition; and

(e) whether any study has been done of the possible benefits of such a policy?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI SUKH RAM): (a) A proposal is under consideration of the Government to licence for provision of basic Telecom service in the rural areas and also in the Industrial Growth Centres to Private entrepreneurs, in order to supplement the effort of the Department to provide Telecom Service in the country.
