

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K. C. LENKA): As compared to the corresponding period of the preceding year 1992-93, there has been increase of Rs. 502.73 crores in total revenue earnings which includes increase of Rs. 124.80 crores in passenger earnings. However, with reference to the proportionate target of first quarter of the current financial year 1993-94, there has been a shortfall of Rs. 232.13 crores in revenue earnings. The shortfall in revenue earnings mainly relates to Goods traffic and is attributable to less offering of traffic from the core sectors. There is also drop in passenger earnings compared to targets which is mainly due to anticipated growth not materialising.

#### Construction of Dimapur Railway Station

4120. SHRI VIZOL: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Dimapur Railway Station was constructed by Britishers during pre-independence days;

(b) if so, the year of its construction with details of facilities provided at that time;

(c) whether it is a fact that no extension of these facilities has been made since then although traffic has increased many folds;

(d) whether Government propose to take some action in this regard; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K. C. LENKA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The details in this regard are not readily available.

(c) to (e) The facilities at this station have been augmented whenever so warranted by growth in passenger traffic. Recently, renovation/face lifting of the station building has been completed at a cost of Rs. 15.77 lakh.

#### Checking of Attendance in Rail Bhavan

4121. SHRI SYED SIBTEY RAZI: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that attendance checks in Rail Bhavan have been conducted every week during January to July, 1993;

(b) if so, the details thereof date-wise and month-wise;

(c) whether it is also a fact that a list of late-comers has been sent to administrative Unit conducting such checks every week during the period January to July, 1993;

(d) if so, the details of late-comers category-wise during each month;

(e) whether such checks have not been conducted in rooms occupied by Stenographers, Private Secretaries, officers and staff of Board Members;

(f) whether Department of Personnel have laid down some guidelines for such exception in such checks;

(g) whether no such checks have been conducted at the departure time in Rail Bhavan during January to July, 1993;

(h) whether it is also a fact that no such checks have been conducted at Railway Station and other public dealing places under the Indian Railways during January to July, 1993 to ensure punctuality amongst staff; and

(i) if so, the reasons therefor separately for (c) to (h)?
