(d) what are the training schools at present working in Madhya Pradesh under the scheme?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS) WITH ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKUL WASNIK): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir, A scheme entitled SCHEME FOR TRAINING OF YOUTH was introduced in 1986-87 and an amount of Rs. 261.5 lakhs has been spent under this scheme.

(c) Ever since the inception of the scheme, an amount of Rs. 4.7 lakhs has been released to the State of Madhya Pradesh to train 264 youths.

(d) There are no permanent training schools under this scheme. The Department releases money to the State Government as well as other reputed voluntary organisations on the basis of viable proposals received and the assistance is limited to the duration of the project.

**Youth activities in backward and rural areas of Madhya Pradesh**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS) WITH ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKUL WASNIK): (a) and (b) There is no scheme for promoting youth activities only in the backward and rural areas, however, a special scheme for promotion of youth activities amongst youth of backward tribes has been introduced from 1990-91. A budget estimate of Rs. one crore was provided during 1990-91 under the same scheme.

(c) Rs. 27.61 lakhs was utilised.

(d) Financial assistance under the scheme is released on the basis of viable proposals received. During 1990-91, nothing was released to Madhya Pradesh under this scheme.
