(b) if so, the details in this regard; and

(c) what results have so far been achieved?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI RAJESH PILOT): (a) to (c) The Army has always been deployed in the border State of J&K and with the advent of militancy and terrorism in the State, has also been involved in anti-militancy operations, as an aid to civil authorities alongwith the Para Military Forces and the State Police. No specific areas have been handed over to the army. Efforts are being made to bring about greater integration and coordination in the operations of these forces with a view to dealing with the terrorists effectively and reducing the fear of the gun among the people. As a result of these efforts significant successes have been achieved against the militants. More than 2000 militants including 624 this year have been killed, including a number of their senior leaders and local Commanders. Large quantities of arms and ammunition, including about 1000 rifles of the AK Series, have also been recovered, so far.

Custodial deaths

(b) the details of custodial deaths and other custodial crimes, including rapes on women and girls during custody, during January, 93 to June, 93 in Delhi and other Union Territories;

(d) the steps taken to prevent such cases?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI P. M. SAYEED): (a) to (d) The information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House.

Incidents of rape by security forces, personnel

338. SHRI S. S. AHLUWALIA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that incidents of rape on innocent women by the Security forces, personnel have risen manifold in Jammu and Kashmir and recently many soldiers have been arrested in this regard;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof;

(c) what action Government have taken or propose to take to prevent incidents of rape on women by personnel of Security forces in the Kashmir Valley; and

(d) what action Government propose to take to rehabilitate the rape victims of the Valley?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI RAJESH PILOT): (a) to (d) It is completely incorrect to say that incidents of rape on innocent women by the security forces personnel have risen manifold in the recent past. Wherever any isolated cases come to notice immediate inquiries are conducted. As a result of inquiries in one such case, where a woman was alleged to have been raped on 25 May, 1993, four personnel were arrested immediately and court Martial proceedings launched.

Strict instructions have been issued that if any such cases come to notice, severe action will be taken against the concerned persons under the Law.
