

रेलगाड़ियों को समय पर चलाया जाना

394. श्री शंकर दयाल सिंह : क्या रेल मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) क्या सरकार के पास विगत तीन महीनों के दौरान विभिन्न स्थानों से पुरानी दिल्ली, नयी दिल्ली तथा निजामुद्दीन रेलवे स्टेशनों पर विलम्ब से आई तथा समय पर पहुंची रेलगाड़ियों के संव्रध में कोई आंकड़े हैं ;

(ख) क्या यह सच है कि पिछले छः महीनों से देश के लगभग सभी स्थानों से रेलगाड़ियां विलम्ब से चल रही हैं ; और

(ग) यदि हां, तो इसके मुख्य कारण क्या हैं और रेलगाड़ियों का समय पर चलाया जाना सुनिश्चित करने के लिए सरकार द्वारा क्या कार्यवाही की जा रही है ?

रेल मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री के. सी. लेंका) : (क) जी, हां।

(ख) और (ग). जी, नहीं। तथापि, खतरे की जंजीर खींचने और अन्य शरारतपूर्ण गतिविधियों, दुर्घटनाओं, आंदोलनों/बंदों, कुहासे, खराब मौसम और उपस्कर की खराबियों आदि के कारण गाड़ियां कभी-कभी विलम्ब से भी चलती हैं। रेलों के नियंत्रणाधीन हकदमों को समाप्त करने के लिए, गहन चैनिंग और रात-दिन मॉन्टिंग सहित, सभी उपाय किये जा रहे हैं।

Quota for various trains at Nagpur

395. DR. SHRIKANT RAMOHANDRA JICHKAR: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) what is the total quota of berths available daily on various trains at Nagpur Station for the Directions of Delhi, Bombay, Calcutta and Madras;

(b) whether there is any demand for increasing in this quota of reservations in various categories; and

(c) if so, what action is being taken?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K. C. LENKA): A total of 1679 berths/seats are available at Nagpur for Delhi, Bombay, Calcutta and Madras in daily trains

terminating/passing through these stations. Besides this accommodation is also available for Delhi & Madras in weekly/tri-weekly/tri-weekly and 4 days in a week trains.

(b) Yes, Sir.

(c) The demand has been examined and it has not been found feasible to provide additional quotas in the existing trains going to Bombay, Madras, Delhi & Calcutta and beyond. However, accommodation has been provided at Nagpur for Delhi and Madras in the new trains introduced from July, 1993.

Expansion of the Nagpur Railway Station

396. DR. SHRIKANT RAMOHANDRA JICHKAR: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) what is the present status of the expansion of the Nagpur Railway Station;

(b) what amount is being spent on this expansion programme this year; and

(c) what is actually planned to be done under this expansion programme?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K. C. LENKA): (a) to (c) Expansion/Development of stations is a continuous process. Accordingly, developmental works involving extension to cover over platforms No. 1/2 and 4/5; extension of footover bridge and provision of booking office, circulating area, etc. and extension of footover bridge at Itarsi and have been completed at a cost of Rs. 87.51 lakh. Presently, works pertaining to provision of washable apron on platform No. 6/7, extension of washable apron on platform No. 1/2 and computerisation of passenger reservation system have been taken up at an estimated cost of Rs. 125.18 lakh. An allocation of Rs. 35.22 lakh has been made for these works during 1993-
