

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA) : (a) A total of about Rs. 68.38 lakhs was received by NCERT from UNICEF as cash and supply assistance during the last three years.

(b) These grants were used for implementation of programmes viz., Area Intensive Education Project for Human Resource Development (AIEP), Early Childhood Education Programme (ECE), Project Integrated Education for Disabled (PIED) as well as for spill over activities of projects.

(c) UNICEF evaluated the Early Childhood Education (ECE) Programme in 1991. On the basis of evaluation, the project has been extended till 1995. The Area Intensive Education Project for Human Resource Development (AIEP) was reviewed by an external expert after three years of its initiation. On the basis of the review the project was recast and extended till 1995. The revised programme of AIEP has also been extended to more blocks.

Construction of Stadia and Swimming Pools in Colleges

(b) Does not arise.

(c) The Scheme of 'Grants for Games and Sports in Universities and Colleges', inter-alia, provides Central assistance for construction of Indoor/ Outdoor Stadium and swimming pool through University Grants Commission. In case of Agriculture Colleges/University, Medical Colleges, and Engineering Colleges, this grant is disbursed directly by the Department. The Central assistance is provided to meet 75% of the estimated cost of the project subject to stipulated ceilings. As per the scheme, the assistance is disbursed after the grantee has fully spent its share over and above the admissible Central assistance in the cost of the project and submits the documents in support thereof.

(d) 19 Colleges have been assisted through University Grants Commission during the last three years for construction of indoor stadium (gymnasium) as per details given in the enclosed statement.
