New Hostels for Working Women

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government propose to set up new hostels for working women during the ensuing year 1993-94;
- (b) if so, what are details in this regard including their proposed capacity, location and estimated cost; and
- '(c) what is the capacity of the existing working Women's hostels, State and Union Territorywise?

(b) and (c) A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

Statement

A budget provision of Rs. 7 crores has been made for the year 1993-94 .to meet the committed liabilities in respect of Working Women's Hostels sanctioned upto 31-3-1993 . and to provide hostel . accommodation to 2,500.. additional working women. Location of such hostels depends. upon receipt of proposals from eligible organisations including registered Voluntary Organisations, Public Trusts, Women Development Corporations, local bodies etc. duly recommended by the State Government or Union Territory Administration. proposals are considered on the basis estimates of number of

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single working women requiring hostel facilities at the particular location and suitability of the organisation proposing to set up the hostel. Assistance is approved to the extent of 75% of the cost of the construction of the building and 50% of the cost of land. Assistance on the same pattern is also made available for purchase of ready-built buildings.

The Scheme requires estimates to be prepared on the basis of prevailing PWD/CPWD Schedule of Rates.
