Pending Proposals of Andhra Pradesh

1862. DR. NAREDDY THULASI REDDY: Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) how many works have been sanctioned in Andhra Pradesh under Central Road Fund since 1989-90 till date;

(b) what is the cost of those works;

(c) as per revised estimates how much amount has to accrue to Andhra Pradesh under CRF since 1989-90 till date;

(d) how many works of A.P. under C.R.F. are pending with Government of India;

(e) what are the reasons for pending; and

(f) when these works will be sanctioned?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER): (a) to (f) Government of Andhra Pradesh sent 401 proposals costing Rs. 289.27 crores for consideration against projected accrual of C.R.F. on the basis of Revised Resolution on augmentation of the Fund adopted by the Parliament. As actual

taken place so far only 5 schemes costing Rs. 1621.40 lakhs have been approved since 1989-90, the Central Government share being Rs. 981.40 lakhs based on the accruals upto March, 1997 as per Old Resolution. The pending proposals cannot be considered for sanction unless the funds are augmented as per the revised resolution.

जल-भूतल परिवहन मंत्रालय के राज्य मंत्री (श्री जगदीश बाइदलर) : (क) जी हाँ ।

(ख) परिवहन के व्यक्तिगत साधनों की अपेक्षा सार्वजनिक परिवहन को बढ़ावा देने के लिए राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र दिल्ली की सरकार ने निजी प्रचालकों के लिए 3000 स्टेज कैरिज परमिटों की स्कीम लागू की है । इस समय परिवहन के व्यक्तिगत साधनों का प्रयोग करने वाले यात्रियों को सार्वजनिक परिवहन की ओर उन्मुख करने के लिए राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र दिल्ली की सरकार ने व्हाइट लाइन बसों के लिए 600 विशेष स्टेज कैरिज परमिटों की स्कीम लागू की है । दिल्ली परिवहन निगम ने उन यात्रियों को जो भीड़ भाड़ वाली शहरी बसों में यात्रा नहीं कर सकते, तीव्र तथा आरामदायक यात्रा सुविधा प्रदान करने के लिए ग्रीन लाइन बसें चलाई है ।

राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र दिल्ली की सरकार ने सस्ती परिवहन सुविधा प्रदान करके अकेले यात्रियों की आवश्यकताओं को पूरा करने के लिए प्वाइंट टू प्वाइंट मोटर साईकिल टैक्सी सेवाएं लागू करने का निर्णय लिया है ।
