(b) and (c) Exploration so far carried out by State Government of Bihar Sonu Block, Karmatiya Village, Munger listrict have indicated low gold between less than 0.1—1.8 glt of The data obtained so far are not sufficient to establish reserves. Gold mining can be considered only after technoeconomic viability of the deposits is esablished. Checking of illegal mining of ninerals is governed by the ules of the State Government.

International price of copper has registered (a) whether it is a fact that Geological declining trends recently due to sluggish Survey of India has discovered a huge market conditions which too has affected deposit in a remote realisable copper prices particularly when village in Singhbhoom District of Bihar; copper metal is freely importable now.
