THE MINISTER OF WELFARE (SHRI SITAE AM KESRI) : (a) The Year 1993 has not been declared as the "Year of Disabled".

(b) to (d) The vocational training is given to the disabled persons through the Non-Governm;ntal Organisat'ons. Under the Central scheme of assistance to organisations for the disabled persons, voluntary organisations in North-Eastern Region are given financial assistance for undertaking educational as well as vocational training to the disabled.

## Backlog of Vacancies for the PhysicaOj Handicapped Persons

2200. DR. NARREDDY THULASI REDDY: WiU the Minister of WELFARE be pleased to state:

(b) As per the available information 399 group 'C posts and 233 group 'D' posts reserved for handicapped persons are lying vacant as on 1-7-1992 in varioti Ministries[Departments and Public Sectoi Undertakings.

(c) and (d) Special Recruitment Drive; were undertaken in 1987, 1988 and 199( to fill up the backlog of vacancies reserv ed for visual and hearing handicappec for group 'C and 'D' posts. This is ; continuous process and Special Recruit ment Drives for handicapped persons an conducted from time to time.

## Setting up of an Artificial Limb Manufac hiring Centre in A.P.

(c) ALIMCO, Kanpur s the only Pub-lie Sector Company under the Administrative Control of this Ministry and following products are manufactured for the handicapped persons :

(i) Lower Extremity Orthotics, (ii) Upper Extremity Orthotics (iii) Lower Extremity Prosthetics (iv) Upper Extremity Prosthet'cs (v) Rehabilitation Aids.

(e) and (f) Does not arise.
