academically autonomous and prescribes its own courses of study. However the UGC has issued guidelines for restructuring of courses at the first degree level which inter alia provide for foundation courses foundation courses, amongst others cover study of the history of freedom movement in India, including national integration, social and cultural history of India etc.

## Nutrition and Child Development

- (a) whether the President of the Nutrition Foundation of India has suggested to create a central nodal agency under the charge of the Prime Minister for nutrition and child development; and
- (b) if so, what is the response of Government to this suggestion?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RE-SOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DE-AND PARTMENT OF WOMEN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI-CHILD MATI BASAVA RAJESHWARI): (a) Yes Sir. The President of the Nutrition Foundation of India has suggested the creation of a central nodal agency under the charge of the Prime Minister for Nutrition and Child Development in his 9th John Barnabas Memorial Lecture entitled "Child Care in India: Emerging Challenges" ganised by the National Institute of Public Cooperation and Child Development in Delhi on 29.3.93.

(b) A National Children's Board already exists with Prime Minister as President and is a National Forum for planning reviewing and coordinating various services for meeting the needs of the children.

## Identification of Sports talents in schools

THE MINISTER OF STATE THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN SOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPART-MENT OF YOUTH AFFAIRS SPORTS) WITH ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PAR-LIAMENTARY **AFFAIRS** MUKUL WASNIK); (a) Government through the Schemes of Sports Authority of India e.g. National Sports Talent Contest Schome (NSTC). Sports Project Development Area Scheme (SPDA) and Army Boys Sports Companies (ABSC), scout and nurture talent available in schools sector in the following Olympics disciplines:-

Archery, Athletics Badminton, Boxing Cycling Football, Gymnastics, Hockey, Judo, Swimming, Table Tennis and Wrestling

(b) The details are given below: -

National Sports Talent Contest Scheme (NSTC). This scheme is meant to scout and nurture school children in the age group of 8 to 12 years. The selected children are admitted to Adopted Schools and given free board, lodging education, training and sports kit and also provided medical and insurance cover, 1014 children are presently under training in 54 adopted schools.

Project Development Sports Area Scheme (SPDA)

This scheme covers schools children of the age group of 8 to 14 years. The

selected children are provided facilities of free board lodging, education sports kit, training, insurance, medical cover etc., as are provided in the NSTC Scheme. 681 children are presently undergoing training under this scheme in 31 centres.

Army Boys Sports Companies (ABSC): This is an extension of NSTC scheme to raise Army Boys Sports Companies in collaboration with the Army authorities. Under this scheme, children in the age group of 8 to 14 years are covered. The facilities provided to NSTC students are extended to the students selected under the scheme. 13 Army Boys Sports Companies have already been established so far and total number of children presently under this scheme are 470
