SHRI JAGESH DESAI (Maharashtra): Sir, I want to bring one fact to the notice of the House that last month, the Chancellor of Germany visited this country and a protocol has been signed between the Government of India and Germany for two power plants—one for Maharashtra and another... (Interruptions)

THE VICE-CHAIRMAN (SHRIV, NARAYANASAMY): No, no. We have to adjourn the House for lunch.

SHRI JAGESH DESAI: The Government of India should expedite that because we are getting the financial assistance from Germany and that project should also be expedited.
