1180. श्री राम जेठमलानी: क्या रेल मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि:

(क) क्या यह सच है कि सरकार ने असिया ब्राउन बोवोरी कंपनी से 6 हजार अश्व शक्ति वाले विद्युत इंजनों की खरीद के संबंध में अंतिम निर्णय ले लिया है;

(ख) यदि हां, तो कितने इंजन खरीदे जाने का प्रस्ताव है और उनकी कुल कीमत कितनी होगी;

(ग) क्या सरकार ने इन इंजनों के रख-रखाव इत्यादि पर भविष्य में आवश्यकता पड़ने वाले अतिरिक्त कल पुर्जों की सप्लाई का उपबंध किये जाने के संबंध में विचार किया है; और

(घ) यदि हां, तो क्या इंजनों के रख-रखाव के लिये आवश्यक सामग्री, अतिरिक्त कल पुर्जे तथा मकैनिक देश में ही उपलब्ध हो सकेंगे, यदि नहीं, तो उनके आयात के संबंध में क्या व्यवस्था की गयी है?

रेल मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री के० सी० लेंका): (क) रेल अधिसमय समिति द्वारा नवंबर, 1992 में प्रस्तुत रिपोर्ट के आलोक में यह मामला सरकार के विचाराधीन है।

Expansion of Railway Lines in Bihar

1181. DR. RAMENDRA KUMAR YADAV 'RAVF': Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have received proposals to expand the Railway lines in Bihar, where Railway lines do not exist; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.C. LENKA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Proposals have been received for providing rail links to Hazaribagh and Dumka in areas not having railway lines at present. The surveys carried out for this purpose have revealed that these lines would not have adequate traffic

potential. As such, they could not be considered. One proposal for a new line from Ranchi to Hazaribagh road with a connection to Koderma was referred to the Planning Commission in '91 but was not agreed to by them. Survey for a new line to connect Dumka either with Mandar Hill or' to the Sahibganj loop has since been taken up.

Broad-Gauge Rail Link between Ankola and Hubli

1182. SHRI J.P. JAVALI: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal for a new broad-gauge rail link between Ankola and Hubli;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof; and

(c) by when the construction of the new line is proposed to be taken up and completed?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.C. LENKA): (a) and (b) A survey for construction of new BG line between Ankola & Hubli was carried out in 1992. The cost of 164 kms length of new BG line was assessed at Rs. 236.80 crores with a rate of return of 16.7%. However, in the meantime, conversion of Hospet-Hubli-Goa (489 kms) has been approved under Project Unigauge. Consequent to this a reappraisal of traffic potential on the proposed line is being done.

(c) Further action would depend on the results of the reappraisal and availability of resources in the coming years.
