

The other point is that Mr. Padmanabham insisted that the Railway Minister should make a statement in the House. I agreed. After that I went and discussed this matter with the Railway Minister. He said that he was willing to come and clarify all the doubts about it in the minds of the Members. Subsequently I told the Parliamentary Affairs Minister, Margaret Alva, also and I also told Mr. Padmanabham that day ... *(Interruptions)* I know, I know.

SHRI MENTAY PADMANABHAM: Yesterday itself we raised this issue, Madam, and then you clarified it.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Yesterday also. You raised it the day before yesterday also. You raised it yesterday also. I observed. 'As there is a lot of pending Government Business, we cannot take it up today or tomorrow. We may take it up when the Railway Minister comes to the House to reply to the discussion on the Railway Budget which we had in the House.' This is the thing.

It is a part of the record. I am sure, the Chairman knows about it, that this is a part of the record. The Chairman is not so ill-informed, I must inform the Member who said that the Chairman might not be knowing about it. There is nothing which the Chairman does not know of. Everything I sincerely report to the Chairman. So, the Chairman knows about it. The Chairman, in his wisdom, has allowed some matter to be raised by Mr. Gurudas Das Gupta. I am not aware of what issue he is raising. I cannot know about it until and unless he raises it. If there is anything objectionable, I assure the House that I will not allow it to go on record.

Now that we have got over our technical problem. I think, Mr. Gurudas Das Gupta, within those parameters if you want to speak, please speak.

RE IRREGULARITIES IN THE AWARD OF CONTRACT BY THE RAILWAYS

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: The main point is irregularity in the award of contract by the Railways. The first point is- that the Railways had offered to a firm manufacture of sleepers as far back as in 1988. After one year, in 1989, the offer of the contract was given to Rayalseema Sleepers. The Rayalseema Sleepers were categorically told that they will have to manufacture the sleepers in a particular place. Chan-takani is the place where they were to manufacture these sleepers. That was under the contract given. But the contract was not met by the firm to which it was awarded. Where is the irregularity? In 1988, the offer of contract was made by the Railways, in 1989, the contract was given to a firm, but for four years that firm does not agree to enter into a contract with the Railways. It was an unusual delay of five years. Why was the delay? The delay was because the firm to which the contract was given did not agree to locate the manufacturing unit in that place, where they were asked to do it by the Railways because that place was a place infested by militant activities. Therefore, for five years the contract remained pending and for five years there was a war of correspondence between the Rayalseema Sleepers and the South-Central Railway. This situation undergoes a dramatic change in 1992. That gives rise to suspicion. The dramatic change takes place because suddenly a partnership is formed. This partnership is known as V. S. Engineering. This partnership, not according to my information, but according to the papers that I have with me was formed on 6th April, 1992. I have with me the Partnership Deed. I have also with me the Income-Tax Clearance. Both the papers show that the partnership was formed on 6th April, 1992. Incidentally, in the Income-tax clearance it is shown that the Managing

(Shri Gurudas Das Gupta)

Director of this Engineering firm does not pay income-tax. My wife pays income-tax, but such a firm which has got such an important contract, is headed by a Managing Director, who does not pay income-tax! This is the first point. The second point is that the agreement that was pending for over five years was suddenly signed by the Rayal-seema enterprise with the Railways after the formation of the partnership agreement. That agreement was signed on 17th June, 1992. I have also got a copy of the agreement which categorically suggests that the location, of the factory will have to be in Chantakani, the original place where the Railway had suggested that the factory should be situated. This is the third piece of paper I would like to lay on the Table of the House. Suddenly on 10th of July, the Railway agreed to enter into a tripartite agreement. The Award was given to Rayalseema Sleepers, but after five years they agreed that the contract should be executed in company with another engineering firm. It was a partnership which had come into existence after five years of the contract. The firm is headed by a farmer with no knowledge, with no expertise in engineering and in construction at all. Therefore, my third point is—

SHRI VITHALRAO MADHAVRAO JADHAV (Maharashtra): Madam, I have a point of order.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Mr. Gupta, let me listen to his point by order.

SHRI VITHALRAO MADHAVRAO JADHAV: The hon. Member is levelling allegations against the farmers. He says that farmers do not have any knowledge. I strongly object to this. He is underestimating the farmers community of this country. He must take back his words. He should know that farmers are architects of

this country. I am myself a farmer. I know about the business also. So the hon. Member must take back his words. He is indulging in character assassination of farmers of this country.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I think we should not cast any aspersion against any kind of profession.

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: Madam, what is this?

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Please keep farmers out of it.

SHRI VITHALRAO MADHAVRAO JADHAV: Madam, he must take back his words.

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: Madam, then, the most important thing takes place. The tripartite agreement takes place involving the VS engineering firm. Five days after the tripartite agreement, the location of the factory was changed. For five years, the Railways were insisting in not changing the location of the factory. After five years, it has been suddenly changed. Within five days after the tripartite agreement was signed, after ten days, after the partnership came into existence, the Railways have found it fit to change the location of the factory. The place of location is changed, it is changed...

SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY (Pondicherry) : Madam, what is the time allotted to him?

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I do not know why he is taking so long. Mr. Gupta, we have other business to transact.

SHRI KAMAL MORARKA (Rajasthan.) : Madam, through him for the first time, we are understanding about the issue.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Mr. Gupta, I have a lot of names for the so-called Zero Hour itself. Then, I have special mentions.

SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY: Madam, I do not know when Mr. Gupta has become a spokesman of the *Indian Express*,

SHRI JAGESH DESAI (Maharashtra) : Madam, we have very important issues to be raised.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: If you do not interrupt him, I will see to it that he concludes soon.

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: This unusual favour is being shown to a particular engineering firm which is supposed to be headed by a person who was a farmer in profession, with no expertise in engineering at all. Unfortunately,...

SHRI V NARAYANASAMY: He is insulting the farmers.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: He is not saying anything against the farmers.

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: Madam, unfortunately after...

SHRI JAGESH DESAI: A person who heads a firm need not be an expert. Perhaps, the hon. Member does not know about it.

SHRI KAMAL MORARKA: Mr Gupta has not levelled even a single allegation against anybody. Members from the other side are unneces-

sarily getting agitated. His main complaint was: How could the Railways get enlightenment after five years? ...

SHRI S. JAIPAL REDDY: Madam, you were kind enough to identify me. I do not know what promoted you to change your mind.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Nothing promoted me. Nothing prompts me except that I want to follow certain rules and if Somebody liaises a point of order, I should allow him; then, let us see. Mr. Bhandare, you want to speak from the front?

SHRI MURLIDHAR CHANDRAKANT BHANDARE: I am asking your permission.. (Interruptions)

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: All right. I will allow you after he speaks... (Interruptions). There is total disorder. Please let me restore order.

SHRI MURLIDHAR CHANDRAKANT BHANDARE: Madam, the issue involves not only a very important question of the observance of rule of law but also of the procedure by this august House. You have said that we can discuss the conduct of a Chief Minister here. On this, I think I do not agree.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I never said it. I never said it. I want to correct you.

SHRI MURLIDHAR CHANDRAKANT BHANDARE: I withdraw it... (Interruptions) ...

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: If you say so that we are not discussing a matter relating to the Members of the other House. ... (Interruptions) . . . This is how things are misquoted. I never said that you can discuss the conduct of a Chief Minister I said you would say that we can discuss. I did not say that. I do not want a discussion on a matter relating to the States... (Interruptions) ...

SHRI MURLIDHAR CHANDRAKANT BHANDARE: Therefore, my first point of order is, we, the Council of States, ... (Interruptions) ...

DR. ABRAR AHMED: Mr. Chairman has not permitted. Then how can anyone be allowed to speak on

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: He has that? ... (Interruptions) ... speak.

SHRI S. JAIPAL REDDY: Madam, section 116 does not apply here... (Interruptions) ...

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: You better formulate it quickly because I have to adjourn the House for lunch.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I am only saying that the Chairman has not permitted... *(Interruptions)* ...

SHRI SURESH KALMADI: Madam, the High Court itself has stayed it. How can they discuss it? ... *(Interruptions)* .. The High Court itself has stayed it... *(Interruptions)*... how can they discuss it? It is going too far... *(Interruptions)*...

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Mr. Murlidhar Bhandare referred to a section of the Act and said that this cannot be mentioned. That is what he referred to... *(Interruptions)*...
