(ख) से (घ) भारत सरकार ने अगस्त, 1991 से जनवरी, 1993 तक विदेशी कम्पनियों के साथ 2237 विदेशी सहयोग संबंधी मामलों का अनुमोदन किया है । इन अनुमोदनों में 929 ऐसे मामले शामिल हैं जिनमें 51.11 बिलियन रुपये की विदेशी इक्विटी की भागीदारी निहित है ।

#### Production of two-wheelers and four wheeler

(a) whether it is a fact that the production of two wheelers and four wheelers has declined during the April-September, 1992 vis-a-vis their production during April-September, 1991;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(b) the reasons for decline in production; and

(d) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by Government to help the automobile Industry ?

production of two-wheelers and four wheelers except jeeps have declined during April-September, 1992 as compared to the corresponding period of 1991 as will be borne out by the production figures for two-wheelers & four wheelers given below :

(c) The fall in production can be attributed to decline in demand resulting from high credit costs, increase in prices due to increased input costs, reduction in rate of depreciation for customers on cars, enhancement of excise duty on two wheelers and tight credit availability.

(d) Government has since taken remedial action by relaxation of import compression measures, reduction of excise duty on cars lowering of floor level rate of interest etc.
