(c) what steps Government are taking to remedy the situation?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF STEEL (SHRI SONTOST MOHAN DEV): (a) to (c) Due to world-wide recession in the Iron and Steel Industry, there has been some decline in Iron Ore exports. However, iron ore exports from Goa were higher during 1991-92 as comnared to the previous year, 1990-91. Withdrawal of export duty on iron ora in the budget proposals for 1993-94 will provide relief to iron ore exporters.

## Recession in Steel and Iron Ore Mining Industries

1475. SHRI PARMESHWAR KUMAR AGARWALLA: Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Steel and Iron Ore mining industries are facing the worst periods of recession; and

(b) if so the steps being taken to face and to revive the projections in view of the national and international scenario?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF STEEL (SHRI SONTOSH MOHAN DEV): (a) and (b). At present there is some slugishness in demand for steel items which is primarily due to several factors inclu ding tight money market position, seasonal variations in demand and lower off-take by some of the user, industries. The measures contained in the budget proposal for 1993-94 for idnustrial revival are ex-peced to stimulate demanor steel. As regards the iron ore mining industry, there has been some decline in the export demand for Iron Ore due to worldwide recession in the Iron & Steel Industry. However, the indigenous demand for iron ore has been increasing with the setting up of new iron and steel units in the country. Withdrawal of export duty on iron ore in the budget proposals for 1993-94 is also expected to provide relief to the iron ore exporters.

## Water Supply to Visakhapatnam Steel Plant
