Urdu Medium Primary Schools in Delhi Municipal Corporation

1430. SHRI MOAHMMED AFZAL alias MEEM AFZAL: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Urdu Primary schools being run by Delhi Municipal Corporation;

(b) in how many schools Urdu classes are being held in Hindi medium in primary schools;

(c) whether it is a fact that the students passing out of primary Urdu medium schools or parallel Urdu classes do not find seats in middle and secondary schools because they do not have provision of Urdu classes; and

(d) whether it is also a fact that the students per force join Hindi medium classes because they can not afford to go too far off schools?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) and (b) Municipal Corporation of Delhi has intimated that 86 Urdu primary schools are run by them and in 10 Hindi medium primary schools Urdu classes are being held.

(c) and (d) Municipal Corporation of Delhi do not run any Middle/Secondary schools. According to the information furnished by Delhi Admn. admissions in class VI on-

wards is given through the Admn. admissions Plan base on the neighbourhood concept keeping in view the number of students studying in primary classes run by local bodies in a specific locality and also the students likely to seek admissions from the neighbouring States. (d) whether it is also a fact that the students per force join Hindi medium classes because they cannot afford to go too far off schools?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) and (b) Delhi Administration has intimated that

there are 16 Urdu medium schools run by the Delhi Administration and 7 Urdu medium schools are aided by them. Delhi Administration do not run exclusively primary schools.

(c) and (d) Admissions in class VI onwards is given through the Admission Plan based on the neighbourhood concept keeping in view the number of students studying in primary classes run by local bodies in a specific locality and also the students likely to seek admissions from the neighbouring States. Construction of Stadium in District Headquarters

1432. SHRI V. HANUMANTHA RAO: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) what are the schemes under implementation for encouraging the construction of stadium and sports facilities in district headquarters; and

(b) if the answer in part (a) above be in affirmative, the details of such schemes

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS) WITH ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKUL WASNIK): (a) For encouraging the construction of stadium and sports facilities in district headquarters, there is a scheme of Grants for Creation of Sports Infrastructure, under which financial assistance can be availed by State Government

Union Territory Administration for construction of District Sports Complex.

(b) Under the Scheme, Construction of Outdoor Stadium, Playfields, Indoor Hall, Swimming Pool and Sports Hostel can be undertaken. The cost has to be shared on 50:50 basis between the Central Government and the sponsor subject to a ceiling of Rs. 50 lakhs of Central assistance. For Hilly Tribal areas, the Central Government provides 75 per cent of the cost subject to a ceiling of Rs. 75 lakhs.

Organising sports camps

(a) whether Government propose to set up Sports camps in different States with qualified coaches; and

(b) whether any Sports Camps are being organised to create interest in athletics amongst our youth?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS) WITH ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKUL WASNIK): (a) and (b) Coaching camps at different locations are organised from time to time on the request of National and State Federations and Associations. These camps are mainly for preparing national levels team at the senior, Junior and sub-junior levels and are conducted by qualified coaches. These camps are specialised in nature and are means for sports persons who have performed well in State and National Championships. In addition coaches are being provided to various user agencies like Regional Coaching Centres. University Field Stations for providing coaching for various sports including athletics.
