Infrastructure Development for Film Industry

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRIMATI SUSHMA SWARAJ): (a) According to information received from National Film Development Corporation Ltd., film makers from India are going to countries like Malaysia, Singapore and Mauritius etc. for location shooting but not for utilizing "infrastructure" available in these countries.

(b) and (c) The Indian film industry has world class studio and laboratory facilities for film making available at various centers within the country. The Indian film industry is also capable of absorbing the rapid technological changes in this field.
