Services from Bhubaneswar to Bombay and Vizag hare not yet been restored due to operational constraints.

Functioning of Tourism Trade in India

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION AND TOURISM (SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD): (a) and (b) In order to boost tourism to the country and increase foreign exchange earnings, a National Action Plan on Tourism was formulated and presented to the Parliament in May 1992 aiming to achieve 1% of global tourist traffic. The Government, therefore, with a view to develop tourism have been giving various incentives to the travel trade from time to time in the form of tax reliefs, interest subsidies, concessional import duty on certain capital goods etc. This has yielded the desired results and tourism industry at present is one of the largest net earners of
