THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA): (a) to (c) According to the information furnished by Delhi Administration, 120 in-service teachers training programmes were organised by SCERT, Delhi Admn. with academic support from NCERT during summer vacation in the year 1992-93. Three programmes for Urdu medium schools for primary Teachers, two programmes for two weeks and one programme for three weeks duration, were organised. In service programmes for PGIs were organised in 1990 by Delhi Administration in collaboration with Urdu Academy.

(d) The SCERT proposes to organise three weeks in service teachers programme for Trained Graduate Teachers level exclusively for Urdu Teachers in August, 1993 for which a work-shop for formulation of course content is being held from 10-12 March, 1993.

(b) Under the Special Area Games (SAG) Scheme of SAI, tribal areas of Srikakulam, Vishakhapatnam, Khammam, East and West Godavari were covered for talent scouting for modern Archery. During the period 1986-87 and 1989 talent scouting for Archery was carried out in the above regions.
