THE MINISTER OF WATER RE SOURCES AND THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY **AFFAIRS** (SHRI VIDYACHARAN SHUKIA): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The Committee submitted its report in December, 1988. The report of the Committee was sent lo all concerned State and Central Departments. Subsequently it was also reviewed by an Empowered Committee and follow up action 10 be taken were sent to them in Janu-arj. 1991.

(c) The lermg of reference were to jeview all flood management activities and suggest recommendations for prioritisatioi of schemes, then-financing and maintenance. The main recommendations covering both short term and long-term measures lay stroes on nonstructural measures such as flood forecasting and flood pro sling, early completion of ongoing schemes, their evaluation and proper maintenance of flood manage men't works

### Opening of Centrai and Navodaya Schools in U.P.

- (a) number of Central Schools functioning in the State of U.P.;
- (b) whether this number is Proportionate to its population-
- (c) if not, the number of such schools likely to be opened in the State during 1998-94; and
- (d) the number of Navodaya Vidyalayas functioning in the State at present and proposed to be opened during 1993-94?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RE SOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) 111 Kendriya Vidyalayas are functioning in U.P. at present.

- (b) and (c) Kendriya Vidyalayas are not opened on the oasis of the population of a State. These Vidyala yas are primarily for the children of tr&nsferably Central Government employees including defence and para-military personnel. Specific locations where new schools are to be opened in 93-94 have not been decided.
- (d) Out of 63 districts in U.P. 44 districts are covered by one Navodaya Vidyalaya in each district. The Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti is keen to open one Vidyalaya in each district as soon as requisite facilities are made available by the State Govern, ment and financial resources are provided.

(c) MRTP/FERA companies have been permitted to enter the area of certified high yielding seeds from 3986. In the New Policy on Seed Development,1988 provisions have been made for adequate trials, import of technology/parental seeds, restriction ton bulk import on recurrent basis for coarse cereals, pulses, oilseeds and fodder seeds. Bulk import of wheat and paddy seeds, was not considered in the Policy. Sale of certified seed is compulsory for MRTP/FERA companies.
