

Financial aid to Brahmaputra Board

2274. SHRI TARA CHARAN MAJ-UMDAR; Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state the total amount/grant-in-aid provided to the Brahmaputra Board since its inception till the end of the Financial Year 1992-93; year-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT WITH ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI P. K. THUNGON): The total amount of grants-in-aid provided yearwise to the Brahmaputra Board since its inception in 1981-82 and till the end of financial year 1991-92 in crores of rupees are: 0.10, 2.00, 10.20, 6.50, 8.00, 7.00, 5.75, 5.00, 6.65, 4.82 and 9.02. For the year 1992-93 an amount of Rs. 6.51 crores has been granted and an additional amount of Rs. 1.57 crores is envisaged to be released before March, 1993.

Sunkosh river Project

(a) whether it is a fact that the Sunkosh river project in Bhutan have considerable potential of irrigation in India;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT WITH ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI P. K. THUNGON): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. The area that can be irrigated in India is 8.6 lakh hectares. The parts of the country likely to be irrigated include the areas in Assam and West Bengal.
