BAMC's Opposition to Ordinance regarding Ayodhya

2741. CHOWDHRY HARI SINGH: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Babri Masjid Movement Coordination Committee made an announcement recently that the acquisition of certain areas in Ayodhya through Ordinance recently was totally unacceptable to it and to the Muslim community in general;

(b) the steps proposed by Government to meet this;

(c) whether it is a fact that they have rejected the reference to the Supreme Court under Article 143(i) on a historical issue; and

(d) how does Government propose to deal with the matter?

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI S. B. CHAVAN): (a) & (d) The Babri Masjid Movement Coordination Committee had rejected the acquisition of land through the Ordinance and the Presidential Reference to the Supreme Court under article 143(i) of the Constitution. The Government have announced that the acquired area excluding the area on which the disputed structure stood, would be made availa-

ble to two Trusts, which would be set up for the construction of a Ram Temple and a Mosque respectively and for planned development of the area. In the Presidential Reference it has been made clear that the Government proposes to settle the Ram Janam Bhoomi Babri Masjid dispute after obtaining the opinion of the Supreme Court and in terms of the said opinion.

Continuing activities by banned organisations in U.P.

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to a news report appeared in the 'Hindustan Times' dated the 13th January, 1993 stating that the ban on R.S.S., V.H.P. in Uttar Pradesh is an eye-wash and that their activities are continuing in a veiled form; and

(b) if so, whether investigations are being taken in Uttar Pradesh to effectively implement the ban on those organisations?

(b) what effective steps were taken to tackle the menace; and

(c) what is the latest report about the existence or otherwise, their activities and plans of such suicide squads; and Government plans to liquidate and eliminate them?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI P.-M. SAYEED): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Security measures were tightened to ensure safety and security of political leaders and police vigilance had been stepped up to neutralise the members of the suicide squads.

(c) The activities of the suicide squads are kept under constant watch.
