3156. SHRI MOHAMMED AFZAL alias MEEM AFZAL : Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state :

(a) the strength of the staff of Bureau for Promotion of Urdu; and the number of posts lying vacant;

(b) what are the reasons thereof; and

(c) what is the number of officials suspended there; and what are the reasons thereof ?

(b) In one case, the selected candidate did not join the post. However, for remaining posts, action has been initiated to fill up these posts through Government Recruiting Agencies.

Athletic events for the next Olympics

3157. SHRI V. HANUMANTHA RAO : Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government propose to concentrate only on a few athletic events for the next Olympics; and

(b) if so, what are the events thus identified ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS) (SHRI MUKUL WASNIK) : (a) and (b) The next Olympic Games are scheduled to be held in 1996. Qualifying standards and procedures for participation in athletics events for these Olympics have not yet been laid down by the International Amateur Athletics Federation, which is the International Governing Body for athletics, and hence no decision can be taken on this issue at this stage.

Nevertheless, with Asian and Commonwealth Games scheduled for 1994, the performance, standards and potential of Indian athletics can be assessed during these Games, which will facilitate taking a decision on which athletics events to concentrate upon for the 1996 Olympics.

Allocation of Assistance to Universities of Southern States
