THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA) : (a) Information is given in the Statement attached. [See below]

(b) Rs. 794.57 Crores has been released so far for Teaching Learning Equipment and salary of additional teacher in single teacher schools and Rs. 89.99 Crores for construction of class rooms by the Government of India.

(c) and (d) The information system under Operation Blackboard has been computerised in the Ministry. Quarterly progress reports are obtained from the States/UTs on various indicators of implementation. As it was found necessary to evaluate implementation and impact of the scheme, NCERT and four other external agencies viz. Operation Research Group, Delhi, G. B. Pant Social Science Institute, Allahabad National Institute of Rural Development, Hyderabad and SANDHAN, Jaipur were entrusted with the evaluation of the first phase of Operation Blackboard.
