

**Validity of Maharashtra Raw Cotton
(Procurement, Processing and
Marketing) Act, 1971**

3564. SHRI MURLIDHAR CHANDRA-KANT BHANDRE : Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state :

(a) whether the State Government of Maharashtra has requested the Central Government for further extension of the validity of Maharashtra Raw Cotton (Procurement, Processing and Marketing) Act, 1971 for a further period of ten years, from June 30, 1993 onwards; and

(b) if so, what is Government's decision in regard thereto ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI G. VENKAT SWAMY) : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The request of the Maharashtra Government is under consideration of the Government.

Functioning of Jute Corporation of India

(a) whether Government are considering to modernise the functioning of the Jute Corporation of India;

(b) whether Government have received any memorandum of demands in this regard; and

(c) if so, the details thereof and the action taken thereon so far?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI G. VENKAT SWAMY) : (a) and (b) No, Sir.

Cotton Production in Guntur and Prakasam Districts of Andhra Pradesh

3566. DR. YELAMANCHILI SIVAJI : Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state :

(a) what is the total quantity of cotton produced in Guntur and Prakasam Districts of Andhra Pradesh and what is the percentage of long staple in it;

(b) what is its share in the national production and the quantity of it is marketed, so far; and

(c) what are the details of the total purchase of cotton by CCI in these districts ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI G. VENKAT SWAMY) : (a) Cotton production during the current cotton season in Guntur and Prakasam Districts of Andhra Pradesh is estimated around 7 lakh bales of which long staple cotton are estimated to account for about 97%.

(b) Total cotton production in Guntur and Prakasam Districts account for 5.54% to 5.45% of the National Production and nearly 72% of it has been marketed so far.

(c) The Cotton Corporation of India has purchased 3.27 lakh quintals equivalent to about 62,250 bales in these Districts as on 15-3-93. The details are as under :
