**Female infanticide in the country**

562. SHRI P. UPENDRA: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether there has been an alarming rise in female infanticide in various parts of the country;

(b) if so, what are the details of such cases in 1992, state-wise; and

(c) what steps Government are taking to curb this evil practice?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI BASAVA RAJESHWARI) (a) and (b) The information is not centrally maintained.

(c) The offences relating to female infanticide are dealt with under the existing provisions of the Indian Penal Code. Various programmes of action and advocacy are also implemented to project a positive image of girl children so as to bring about changes in societal attitudes towards them. A National Plan of Action for the SAARC Decade (1991-2000) of the Girl Child focussing on survival, protection and development of the girl child has been formulated. A special set of interventions for adolescent girls has been institutionalised through the ICDS infrastructure.
