THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRI P. V. RANGAYYA NAIDU): (a) During the calendar year 1992, the energy generation in Madhya Pradesh was 33341 Million Units. The energy received by Madhya Pradesh during the Calendar year 1992 from Central Sector Stations in Western Region, Northern Region and Southern Region was 8917.7 MU, 337.8 MU and 51.5 MU respectively.

(b) The Plant Load Factor of thermal power Stations in Madhya Pradesh during 1992 was 60.3 per cent.

(c) Various measures being taken for optimum utilisation of the installed capacity in Madhya Pradesh include Renovation and Modernisation of old units, assistance to Electricity Boards in undertaking Plant Betterment Programme, supply of requisite quantity and quality of coal, training of Operation and Maintenance personnel and strengthening of Transmission and Distribution System.

Power Plants under Central Electricity Board

(a) what is the number of power plants which are owned by the Central Electricity Board;

(b) how much electricity is generated by the Central Electricity Board, annually;

(c) what are the transmission lines of the Central Electricity Board; and

(d) what is the State-wise break-up of the Central Electricity Board plants?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRI P. V. RANGAYYA NAIDU): (a)

(d) Central Electricity Board is a statutory Body constituted under Section 36-A, of the Indian Electricity Act, 1910. The Board consists of representatives from State and Central Governments, State Electricity Boards, Bureau of Indian Standards, Federation of Electricity Undertakings, etc. It is entrusted with the task of framing Indian Electricity Rules for the whole of the country to regulate generation, transmission, supply and use of electrical energy vide Section 37 of I.E. Act, 1910. The Central Electricity Board does not own any power station or transmission net work.
