

Infant Milk Food

4151. SHRI KRISHAN LAL SHARMA: Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that infant milk food industry in the country is steadily growing and its marketing strategy is unethical;

(b) if so, the reasons thereof; and

(c) the steps being taken to check this?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI TARUN GOGOI): (a) to (c) The production of infant milk food including milk powders during the last 4 years in 1989, 1990, 1991 and 1992 was 1,65,00/ tonnes, 1,55,000 tonnes, 1,50,000 tonnes and 1,65,000 tonnes. The Ministry of Food Processing Industries has not received any complaint about any unethical marketing strategy.

Deaths of new born babies

4153. DR. NAUNIHAL SINGH: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that fifteen lakh new babies die within 23 days of birth every year in the country;

(b) if so, whether it is also a fact that most of these deaths occur in rural areas and many of these are preventable; if so, what measures have been taken by Government to prevent such deaths; and

(c) whether there is any crash programme launched by Government to prevent these deaths and ultimately achieve the goal of population stabilisation?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI PAWAN SINGH GHATOWAR): (a) According to the Sample Registration System (1989) of the Registrar General of India, an estimated 13.2 lakh neonatal deaths occur in the country.

(b) and (c) Yes Sir. The steps taken include prevention of neonatal tetanus through Tetanus Toxoid immunization, training of Traditional Birth Attendants for clean deliveries, provision of disposable delivery kits and training of medical and para medical staff on new born care and encourage institutional deliveries.
