

(e) whether the operators- of these buses have not even displayed the fare being charged by them from passengers;

(f) whether this over charging is with connivance of officials of STA or lack of their interest in official duties to safeguard interests of commuters;

(g) whether Government propose to take some stringent and immediate action in the matter; and

(h) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER): (a) No, Sir.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) Since the routes are temporary the display of fare charts will be considered (after they are established.

(d) No, Sir.

(e) to (h) As stated in reply to (c) above the routes are temporary and permanent permits for 5 years have not been granted. The fare chart will be got displayed by S.T.A. Delhi when the routes are established. Deterent action against the operators is taken whenever any instance of overcharging is reported.

#### **A.P. Proposals pending**

4313. DR. YELAMANCHILI SIVAJI: Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

what are the proposals of A.P. that are pending for approval in his Ministry; and at what stage of consideration are they?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER) : Four estimates each costing more than Rs. 50.00 lakhs pertaining to National Highway works of Andhra Pradesh are pending as on 26.3.1993. These are under different stages of processing. 19 proposals under Centrally aided programme of Inter-State and Economic Importance and 9 proposals for declaring new National Highways have been received. As the allocation of funds under the Central Sector Road Programme during the VIIIth Five Year Plan is meagre, it will be difficult to consider these proposals at this stage.

#### **Construction of fly over on the Nazafgarh Road Intersection at Tilak Nagar**

4314. SHRI RAM DEO BHANDARI: Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a proposal to construct a flyover on the Nazafgarh Road intersection at Tilak Nagar has been Government's consideration for a long time;

(b) if so, since when the proposal is pending and what are the reasons for the delay; and

(c) by when the work on said flyover is likely to be commenced and what is the time schedule for its completion?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER) : (a) to (c) The proposal for construction of fly-over is included in the 8th Five Year Plan. There is no delay in processing the proposal, as the plans for the scheme have already been finalised. As the detailed estimate for the work is yet to be sanctioned, it is too early to indicate the time schedule for its completion.
