(a) the progress of research made by the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi and Indira Gandhi Institute of Patna (Bihar) in the field of fertility control;

(b) the quantum of assistance given by the united States of America to Ali India Institute of Medical Sciences and Indira Gandhi Institute of Patna (Bihar) in this regard; and

(c) by when the results of the research are likely to be made public?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI PABAN SINGH GHATOWAR): (a) and (b) The AIIMS are carrying out research projects in the held of fertility control for the development of newer and safer contraceptive methods through basic and clinical research. The research projects are reported to be progressing satisfactorily. The US held India funds have assigned Rs. 72.16 lakhs to AIIMS for the period 1992—96. The Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Patna (Bihar) have reported that neither such programme has been initiated by that Institute nor any foreign assistance received by them so far in this regard.

(c) The results of the research would be known only after the completion of the projects.
