- (a) the average cost of production of coal at Simlong, Kiludia, Tapli and Rajpura mines of Eastern Coalfields Ltd. (ECL);
- (b) what is the total number of mines in ECL and how many of them are in operation at present;
 - (c) what is the total loss of ECL in 2000-2001; and
- (d) how the productivity indicator "Tons per employee" of CIL compares with the average figures of industry?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COAL (SHRI SYED SHAHNAWAZ HUSSAIN): (a) The average cost of production (Provisional) of coal for the year 2000-2091 of the following mines of Eastern Coalfields Limited (ECL) are given below:—
