Brahmaputra flood Control Board without a Chairman

6188. DR. B. B. DUTTA: Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES fa-pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Bra hmaputra Flood Control Board is func tioning without any Chairman for years together;

(b) if so, the reasons therefor;

(c) whether Government propose to, take some steps to reconstitute the Board to make it function effectively; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and If not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHR P. K. THUNGON): (a) and (b) There has been no regular incumbent as Chairman, Brahmaputra Board since January, 1987,

As suitable candidates were not available, Secretary, North Eastern Council was entrusted the additional charge of Chairman, Brahmaputra Board with the approval of the Cabinet. Since the transfer of the incumbent holding the post of Secretary, North Eastern Council in January, 1993, the Vice Chairman of Brahmaputra Board is exercising and discharging the duties of Chairman, Brahmaputra Board.

(c) No, Sir.

(d) The Brahmaputra Board its functioning effectively and does not need to be reconstituted.

Flood control In Assam

6189. DR. B. B. DUTTA: Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have given any priority towards flood control in Assam and adjoining areas keeping in view the horrible situation arising from floods every year;

(b) if so, the details thereof with programmes drawn up and financial outlay fixed for the current year; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI P. K. THUNGON): (a) and (b) The Union Government have given priority towards flood control in Assam and adjoining areas by setting up the Brahmaputra Board in December, 1981 which has prepared Master Plans for flood management in respect of the Brahmaputra, Barak and its tributaries. These Master Plans have been sent to Assam and other North Eastern States and Central agencies for taking further steps leading to implementation. In addition to the outlay of Rs. 20.00 crore from the State's plan funds, Central Loan Assistance to the tune of

Rs. 25 crore is envisaged for release to Assam for flood control during the current financial year.

(c) Does not arise.
