वस्त्र मंत्रालय के राज्य मंत्री (श्रीजी. वेंकट स्वामी): (क) यद्यपि गैर-प्लान योजनाश्रों के अंतर्गत वर्ष 1991-92 की तुलना में वर्ष 1992-93 के दौरान राज्य सरकारों को कम राणि दी गई है लेकिन प्लान योजनाश्रों के अंतर्गत उन्हें ग्रिधिक राभि दी गई।

(ख) गैर-प्लान योजनाम्रों के अंतर्गत कम राशि इसलिए भी जारी की गई क्योंकि सरकार की नीति है कि जनता कपडा योजना को धीरे -धीरे समाप्त किया जाएं ग्रौर विपणन विकास सहायता अंतर्गत राज्य सरकारें बराबर श्राधार पर **ग्र**पना अंशदान नहीं दे पाई । प्लान योजनात्रों में सहायता में वृद्धि इसलिए संभव हो पाई क्योंकि वर्ष 1991-92 के अन्तिम भाग ग्रौर वर्ष 1992-93 के दौरान कई नई प्लान योजनाएं ग्रारंभ की गई हैं। इन मोजनाम्बों में प्रोजेक्ट पैकेज योजना एकीकृत हथकरवा ग्राम विकास योजना समह बीमा योजना स्वास्थ्य पैकेज योजना भीर संबंधित कार्य-शाला सह-ग्रावास योजना शामिल हैं।

includes representatives of INTUC, NLO, BMS, HMS, AITUC and CITU, has accepted the Plan prepared by the Cotton Textile Research Associations for the modernisation of National Textile Corporation with the provisio that "restructuring with modernisation has to be done at each unit level"

## Opening of fashion training centres

## 2217. SHRI VIREN J. SHAH: SHRI PRAMOD MAHAJAN:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) wheher it is a fact that his Ministry propose to open fashion training centres in different parts of the country to widen the technical base of the garment industry to enable it to face stiff compitition in the fashion-conscious international market;
- (b) if so, what are the details thereof and names of places where these fashion training centres are likely to be opened;
- (c) by when these training centres are likely to be set up and at what cost; and
- (d) what will be Government's share out of the total expenses proposed to be incurred in respect of these training centres?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI G. VENKATSWAMY): (a) to (d) Government are examining the feasibility of setting up a few more institutes of fashion technology in important garment manufacturing centres by involving the concerned State Governments in raising the required resources and in managing the institutes. A final decision regarding the locations and cost sharing arrangement will be taken after discussions with the concerned State Governments.
