Payment of relief to Kashmiri Migrants in Ghaziabad

2434. CHOWDHRY HARI SINGH: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to refer to the answer to Unstarred Question 2882 given in the Rajya Sabha on 22nd December, 1993 and state:

(a) the reasons for non-disbursement of relief to the Kashmiri migrants in Ghaziabad District after March, 1993 till date in spite of the Central advice to the Uttar Pradesh Government to pay such relief expeditiously; and

(b) whether Government are aware that some Kashmiri migrants in Ghaziabad District in Uttar Pradesh have not received the relief even from March, 1992 and if so, the reasons therefor and the action taken or proposed to be taken by the Central Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI RAJESH PILOT): (a) The State Government has been reminded and requested to make available the required funds urgently.

(b) According to available information in the case of 52 families residing

in Tehsil Dadri, District Ghaziabad payments have not been made since different dates from June to December, 1992.

(b) if so, what are the details thereof and what action was taken by the Union Government to check the same?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI P. M. SAYEEDV. (a) No, Sir.

Publication of Islamic Encyclopedia

2436. SHRI JAGMOHAN: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware of the fact that an Islamic Encyclopedia in Malayalam (Islam Vignhana Kosham) has been published by a Kozhikode-based publishing company;

(b) whether the world map published on the opening pages of the encyclopaedia shows Kashmir a part of Pakistan;

(c) whether it is a fact that the present Education Minister of Kerala, Shri E. T. Mohammad Basheer, is a Member of the Advisory Board under whose guidance the encyclopaedia was prepared; and

(d) if the answer to the above questions are in the affirmative, what action Government propose to take in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI RAJESH PILOT): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) No Sir. The map printed on it shows Kashmir as a region where muslims are in majority, comprising over 50 per cent of the population.

(c) Yes, Sir.

(d) The publication contained several objectionable observations. Hence the State Government of Kerala has been advised to take appropriate action against the publisher of this Encyclopaedia.

Spying Activities of J&K Secretariat Officers

SHRI ANANT RAM JAISWAL:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether according to the Central Police Officers, more than two hundred officers of Jammu and Kashmir Secretariat are engaged in spying activities for Pakistan;

(b) whether a list containing the names of these officers was sent to Government some time back; and

(c) if so, what are the details thereof stating the action taken by Government in this matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI RAJESH PILOT): (a) Government have no information about the involvement of more than two hundred officers of the J&K secretariat being engaged in spying activities for Pakistan.

(b) and (c) In view of (a) above, the question does not arise.
