

**Rocket attack in Srinagar**

2421. SHRI IQBAL SINGH: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news-item captioned "Rocket attack on R-Day Stadium in Srinagar" published in the Indian Express dated 27th January, 1994; and

(b) if so, what stringent measures have been/are being taken to prevent such incidents in the State?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI RAJESH PILOT): (a) and (b) The militants had propelled a rocket towards the Bakshi Stadium in Srinagar on 26 January 1994, which hit a water tank outside the stadium. No loss of life or property was caused due to this attack. The attack did not disrupt the Republic Day functions which passed off peacefully.

The security arrangements are being continuously reviewed and action for strengthening streamlining the same being taken on a regular basis.

**Renaming of Andamana and Nicobar Islands**
