#### **Scheme for Rehabilitation of Bonded Labour**

6358. SHRI SUSHILKUMAR SAMBHAJIRAO SHINDE:

SMT. MEENA VERMA-

Will the Minister of PLANNING AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether a Rs. 10 crore Centrally sponsored scheme for the rehabilitation of bonded labour has been drawn out for implementation under the Eighth Five Year Plan;

(b) if so, the salient features of the scheme; and

(c) the progress made so far in the implementation thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION (SHRI GIRIDHAR GOMANGO): (a) to (c) An amount of Rs. 4 crores (revised) has been earmarked for the Centrally sponsored scheme for the Rehabilitation of Bonded Labour under the Eighth Five Year Plan.

In order to supplement the efforts of the State Governments, Central Financial assistance on matching grant (50:50) basis upto a ceiling limit of Rs. 6250 per head is provided for the rehabilitation of identified and released bonded labourers. The pattern of assistance is land-based, non-land based or skill/craft based depending upon the aptitude/skill and preference of the beneficiary.

An amount of Rs. 337.54 lakhs has been released to State Governments as Central share of assistance under the Centrally sponsored scheme during 1992-93 and 1993-94.
