### Limiting Maternity benefits to women employees

6685. **SHRI RAHASBHARI BARIK:** Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state—

(a) whether Government have a proposal to limit the maternity benefits available to women employees,

(b) if so, the decision taken thereon,

(c) the date from which it would be enforced; and

(d) the details thereof?

**THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND):** (a) to (d) A proposal to restrict grant of Maternity Benefit to the woman worker upto two living children only is under examination.

The details of the proposal are yet to be worked out. As such it is not possible to furnish the details.

### MASS Camps for detection of diseases by CGHS authorities in metropolitan cities

6686. **PROF. VIJAY KUMAR MALHOTRA:** Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state—

(a) the number of mass camps organised in the Government residential colonies for the detection of cancer/diabetes/cardiology/oral diseases/ophthalmology/paediatrics by the CGHS authorities in the last three years in Delhi, Bombay, Calcutta and Madras respectively

(b) what are the details thereof,

(c) the benefits accrued therefrom,

(d) the steps taken to keep up organising such camps;

(e) if no such camps have been held, the reasons therefor and the steps taken to organise such camps, and

(f) whether there was a proposal for installation of an X-Ray and Auto Analyser machines in CGHS Dispensary at K K Nagar, Madras,

(g) if so, the reasons for not fulfilling that proposal; and

(h) the steps taken to fulfil that proposal without delay, if not, the reasons therefor?

**THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND):** (a) to (e) CGHS does not organise such camps. Government authorities and NGOs organise camps for detection/treatment of diseases/public health education.

(g) and (h) Orders for procurement of these machines have been placed.
