**Accident of a Stationary Goods Train between Anuppur-Paurhari Railway Station**

6794. SHRI NILOTPAL BASU: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to refer to the answer to Unstarred Question 364 given in the Rajya Sabha on 28th April, 1993 and to state:

(a) whether the General/Subsidiary Rules allow tower wagon along with any other vehicle;

(a) if not, under whose advise the tower wagon was allowed to run and whether this is against safety rules;

(a) what action was taken by Railways against the concerned officials for having allowed tower wagon which resulted in accident; and

(a) whether it is also a fact that high officials are not found accountable for this accident; if not, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C.K. JAFFER SHARIEF): (a) The General Rules of the Indian Railways permit attaching of the tower wagon in section with other vehicles attached, under special instructions.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) and (d) A departmental Inquiry Committee was asked to inquire into this accident and based on their recommendations, suitable punishments have been awarded to the officials found responsible for this accident.

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C.K. JAFFER SHARIEF): (a) and (b) The information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the Sabha.

**Repair/renovation of old bridges in Assam**

6796. SHRIMATI BASANTI SARMA: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Railways have received any proposals for the repair or renovation of old bridges in the State of Assam;

(b) if so, what are the locations; and

(c) the sum of money allocated for this purpose during the year 1993-94?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C.K. JAFFER SHARIEF): (a) and (b) Railways have an elaborate system of inspection of Railway bridges for assessing and monitoring their condition and identifying need for repairs. The requisite repairs are carried out timely and bridges are maintained in safe condition. The identified repair works are carried out by the Railways under their own powers.

(b) Account of expenditure is not maintained state-wise.
