

besides formulation, funding etc., of all types of public irrigation schemes is primarily rests with the concerned State(s) and the collection of statistical data on creation and utilisation or Irrigation potential involves various agencies and programmes; there has been the need as a statistical process to review the figures related to creation of irrigation potential and utilisation through all sources for updation and firming up so as to facilitate better planning. As such the figures of creation of irrigation potential and utilisation through major and medium irrigation at the end of Sixth Plan, during Seventh Plan and the at end of Seventh Plan were firmed up by the concerned administrative Ministry i.e., Ministry of Water Resources, on the basis of an exercise carried out at individual project level and upward by the Central Water Commission in liaison with the State Irrigation departments. Accordingly these figures have been adopted by the Planning Commission in the document of Annual Plan in 1993-94.

#### **Plan outlay for Punjab**

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION (SHRI GIRIDHAR GOMANGO) : (a) An outlay of Rs. 1450.00 crore was proposed by the State Government for the Annual Plan 1994-95 and this has been approved by the Planning Commission. This is against an outlay of Rs. 1250.00 crore for

the Annual Plan 1993-94 indicating; an increase of 16%. Top priority has been given to energy sector particularly Ranjit Sagar Dam, Bhatinda Thermal and Rural Electrification. Priority has also been given to irrigation and rural development. Increasing productivity in the agriculture sector, diversification of crops from wheat and paddy to pulses, oilseeds, sugarcane, cotton and horticulture; greater stress on literacy; improvement and strengthening of technical education; greater health care and providing drinking water facility in all the hard core and water scarcity villages have also been accorded high priority. About 58% of the total plan outlay shall be spent in the rural areas of the States. An amount of Rs. 244.25 crore has been allocated for the implementation of plan schemes at the district level during 1994-95. Employment of over 2.5 lakh is likely to be generated through investments in various sectors and self-employment schemes during 1994-95.

(b) Rates of industrial and agriculture growth contemplated under Annual Plan 1994-95 are 7.02% and 3.44% respectively.
