(a) the target set for the Doordarshan and AIR network coverage for the Eighth Five Year Plan;

(b) the state-wise achievement in this regard so far; and

(c) the details of expansion of made Doordarshan and AIR network planned for Orissa during the remaining period of the 8th Five Year Plan?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND;

BROADCASTING (SHRI K. P. SINGH. DEO): (a) Doordarshan expects to provide TV coverage to 91.8 per cent of the population and 81.4 per cent of the area of the country on completion of the schemes which have been sanctioned/, envisaged so far, as part of 8 th Plan. The target set by AIR- is to provide coverage! to 97.5 per cent of the population and 91.0 per cent of the area of the country on completion of the 8th Plan schemes.

(b) As given in statement-I. (See below).

(c) For expansion of its network, Doordarshan has presently 2 HPTs, and 31 LPTs/VLPTs under implementation in Orissa. The locations for setting of its transmitters during the remaining part of 8th plan are, however, yet to be finalised.
