

Quality of Meals Supplied in Express Trains

7841. SHRI TINDIVANAM G. VENKATRAMAN: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to State:

m

(a) What is the amount charged for a Vegetarian and Non-Vegetarian meal in Express Trains of the Indian Railways;

(b) whether the quality of the food supplied has been checked by the concerned officials during the last two years;

(c) if so, what are their findings; and

(d) if not, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C.K. JAFFER SHARIEF): (a) Current Tariff for Vegetarian and Non-Vegetarian meals is as under:

Casserole Meals	Standard Meals
Vegetarian—Rs. 167- 18/	Rs. 13/-
Non-Vegetarian Rs.	Rs. 18/-

(b) Yes, Sir.

(c) Surprise and regular inspections are being frequently conducted by the Commercial, Medical and other Railway Officers to check quality of food and standard of service provided on Railways. In case of any irregularities immediate remedial action is taken. Besides, samples of food items are also collected by the Health Department for laboratory tests and the Staff/contractor concerned are also suitably taken up if the same are found sub-standard/adulterated etc.

Curtailement in Wagon Procurement

(a) whether it is a fact that the Railway Board has decided to cut down wagon procurement this year; and

(b) if so, what are the details of the wagons procured from Braithwaite & Company Limited, during the year 1992-93, 1993-94 and proposed for 1994-95 and the reasons for cutting down the procurement?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C.K. JAFFER SHARIEF):

(b) The details of wagons procured from Braithwaite from 1992-93 onwards are as follows:
