

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) No, Sir. The requisition for the vacant posts was sent to the Employment Exchange on 24th November, 1993 while the instructions providing for reservation, inter alia, for OBCs were issued by the Government on 22nd December, 1993.

(c) The fresh reservation rosters will be prepared providing for, inter alia, reservation for OBCs in direct recruitments other than in open competition as per Government instructions. This is a lengthy process and will take time. However, no direct recruitments will be made contrary to Government instructions.
