The rate of literacy for males is 73.13% and for females is 48.64%. Gujarat State ranks 14th in the country in the descending order of literacy.

(c) and (d) Government have taken up programmes for universalisation of Elementary Education, Non-Formal Education and Adult i.ducation to achieve "Education For All".

The outlay approved for Gujarat for the 8th Plan is Rs. 162.90 crores and proposed for 1994-95 is Rs. 18.16 crores.
